

**NOTICE OF A TAX INCREASE AND A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE
PROPOSED BUDGET AND PROPOSED TAX LEVIES FOR OKTIBBEHA COUNTY**

The Oktibbeha County Board of Supervisors will hold a public hearing on a proposed ad valorem tax revenue increase for fiscal year 2021-22 and on its proposed budget and proposed tax levies for fiscal year 2021-22 at 2:00 P.M. on September 14, 2021, at the Oktibbeha County Courthouse, 101 East Main Street, in the Board's regular meeting room located on the second floor.

Oktibbeha County is now operating with projected total budget revenue of \$106,482,674, (47.74%) or \$50,830,031 of such revenue is obtained through ad valorem taxes. For the next fiscal year, the proposed budget has total projected revenues of \$105,947,532. Of that amount, (49.15%) or \$52,070,019 is proposed to be financed through a total ad valorem tax levy.

For the next fiscal year, Oktibbeha County plans to increase your ad valorem tax millage rate by 1.07 mills from 123.60 mills to 124.67 mills. This increase means that you will pay more in ad valorem taxes on your home, automobile tags, business fixtures and equipment and rental real property.

Any citizen of Oktibbeha County is invited to attend this public hearing on the proposed budget and tax levies for fiscal year 2021-2022 and shall be allowed to speak for a reasonable amount of time and offer tangible evidence before any vote is taken.

A final decision on the proposed budget and tax levy shall be made on Tuesday, September 14, 2021, at 2:00 P.M. at said public hearing to be held in said Board of Supervisors meeting room.
